



Windshield for Yamaha G-22 Installation Instructions



Windshield



Note: When unpacking windshield, do not remove protective covering with a scraper, razor blade or other tool that may scratch the windshield.

1. Attach Short Strut Bracket to Bottom of vehicle Windshield Strut as shown. Center the Bracket between the hardware that secures Windshield Strut to vehicle. →





2. Attach Windshield Strut Clamps to Windshield Strut as shown. Center clamps between bends in Windshield Strut and hardware that secures Windshield Strut to vehicle.



3. Attach Long Strut Brackets to driver and passenger sides of Windshield as shown.



4. Attach Windshield to Struts. Starting from top of the Long Windshield Bracket, line up bottom of windshield with channels of Short Windshield Strut Bracket.



5. Attach lower ends of Long Windshield Strut Brackets to Windshield Strut and slide bottom of Windshield into channels of Short Windshield Strut Bracket and Windshield Strut Clamps.

6. To secure windshield when unfolded, use clamps on upper portion of windshield.



7. Squeaking may occur, caused by friction between windshield and strut bracket. Application of a spray lubricant (such as WD-40) down channels of Windshield Strut Brackets, should minimize this.
